FURNITURE WITH A CONSCIENCE

All wood used at PBJ Designhouse comes from state approved plantations, where the logs are individually selected and gently harvested.

We often produce furniture with veneer. The reason for this is twofold. It reduces the use of solid timber, thereby conserving natural resources. Secondly, the MDF that the veneer cover is made with recycled wood which is better for the environment whilst still producing a strong and high-quality surface.

All of our timber and veneer are carefully hand sorted so that the grain patterns and color variations are as natural as possible.
